A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO TRAFFIC SAFETY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECT	ION 1. Section 291C-41, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended to	o read as follows:
3	"[+]:	§291C-41[+] Drive on right side of roadway;
4	exception	s. (a) Upon all roadways of sufficient width, a
5	vehicle sl	hall be driven upon the right half of the roadway,
6	except as	follows:
7	(1)	When overtaking and passing another vehicle proceeding
8		in the same direction under the rules governing [such]
9		the movement;
10	(2)	When an obstruction exists making it necessary to
11		drive to the left of the center of the highway;
12		provided that any person so doing shall yield the
13		right-of-way to all vehicles traveling in the proper
14		direction upon the unobstructed portion of the highway
15		within [such] the distance [as to constitute]
16		constituting an immediate hazard;

- 1 (3) Upon a roadway divided into three marked lanes for
 2 traffic under the rules applicable thereon; or
 3 (4) Upon a roadway designated and signposted <u>for</u> one-way
 4 traffic.
- (b) Upon all roadways, any vehicle proceeding at less than 5 6 the normal speed of traffic at the time and place and under the 7 conditions then existing shall be driven in the right-hand lane 8 then available for traffic, or as close as practicable to the 9 right-hand curb or edge of the roadway, except when overtaking 10 and passing another vehicle proceeding in the same direction or 11 when preparing for a left turn at an intersection or into a 12 private road or driveway.
- 13 (c) Upon any roadway having four or more lanes for moving 14 traffic and providing for two-way movement of traffic, no 15 vehicle shall be driven to the left of the center line of the 16 roadway, except when authorized by official traffic-control 17 devices designating certain lanes to the left side of the center 18 of the roadway for use by traffic not otherwise permitted to use 19 [such] the lanes, or except as permitted under subsection 20 (a)(2). This subsection shall not be construed to prohibit the

- 1 crossing of the center line in making a left turn into or from
- 2 an alley, private road, or driveway.
- 3 (d) Upon any two-lane roadway providing for two-way
- 4 movement of traffic, any vehicle proceeding at ten miles per
- 5 hour or more below the posted speed limit where overtaking or
- 6 passing another vehicle is not possible or permitted, and a line
- 7 of five or more vehicles is following immediately behind, shall
- 8 move off the roadway at the nearest safe location where
- 9 sufficient space exists for trailing vehicles to overtake or
- 10 pass the vehicle, unless doing so would result in an unsafe
- 11 situation."
- 12 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 13 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 14 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 3000.

Report Title:

Two-Lane Highways; Traffic Safety; Slow-Moving Vehicles

Description:

Requires vehicles traveling ten miles per hour or more below the posted speed limit on a two-lane highway, behind which five vehicles are formed in a line, to pull over where possible to let the trailing vehicles pass or overtake. Effective 7/1/3000. (HD2)

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
