A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO ENERGY EFFICIENCY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. (a) The department of accounting and general
2 services shall conduct a study on the overall energy consumption
3 by facilities managed, leased, or otherwise maintained by the
4 department, and associated costs. The study shall include but
5 not be limited to:

6 (1) Assessment of current future energy needs;

7 (2) Identification of short- and long-term energy costs;

8 and

9 (3) Recommendations on measures that can be implemented to
10 lower the costs,

11 for the purpose of making the department facilities more energy
12 efficient.

13 (b) The department of accounting and general services
14 shall submit a report of its findings and recommendations,
15 including any proposed legislation, to the legislature no later
16 than twenty days prior to the convening of the regular session
17 of 2025.



1 SECTION 2. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
