A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE TRAFFIC CODE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 291C-111, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 2 amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows:
- 3 "(a) With respect to highways under their respective
- 4 jurisdictions, the director of transportation [is] shall be
- 5 authorized to, and the counties by ordinance may, prohibit or
- 6 restrict the stopping, standing, or parking of vehicles where
- 7 the stopping, standing, or parking is dangerous to those using
- 8 the highway or where the stopping, standing, or parking of
- 9 vehicles would unduly interfere [unduly] with the free movement
- 10 of traffic; provided that the violation of any law or any
- 11 ordinance, regardless of whether established under this or any
- 12 other section, prohibiting or restricting the stopping,
- 13 standing, or parking of vehicles shall constitute a traffic
- 14 infraction. The counties may issue citations for traffic
- 15 infractions for violations of any law prohibiting or restricting
- 16 the stopping, standing, or parking of vehicles on highways. The
- 17 counties shall not provide any other penalty, civil or criminal,



- 1 or any other charge, in the form of rental or otherwise, in
- 2 place of or in addition to the fine to be imposed by the
- 3 district court for any violation of any ordinance prohibiting or
- 4 restricting the stopping, standing, or parking of vehicles.
- 5 This section shall not be construed as prohibiting the
- 6 authority of the director of transportation or the counties to
- 7 allow the stopping, standing, or parking of motor vehicles at a
- 8 "T-shaped" intersection on highways under their respective
- 9 jurisdictions; provided that [such] the stopping, standing, or
- 10 parking of motor vehicles is not dangerous to those using the
- 11 highway or where the stopping, standing, or parking of motor
- 12 vehicles would not unduly interfere with the free movement of
- 13 traffic.
- 14 The appropriate police department or their designee, and
- 15 county or prosecuting attorney of the various counties shall
- 16 enforce any law or ordinance prohibiting or restricting the
- 17 stopping, standing, or parking of vehicles, including but not
- 18 limited to the issuance of parking tickets. Any person
- 19 committing a violation of any law or ordinance, regardless of
- 20 whether established under this or any other section, prohibiting
- 21 or restricting the stopping, standing, or parking of vehicles

- 1 shall be subject to a fine to be enforced and collected by the
- 2 district courts of this State and to be deposited into the state
- 3 general fund for state use."
- 4 SECTION 2. Section 291C-165, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 5 amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows:
- 6 "(a) There shall be provided for use by authorized police
- 7 officers, or [county employees designated by] designees of the
- 8 county chiefs of police, a form of summons or citation for use
- 9 in citing violators of those traffic laws that do not mandate
- 10 the physical arrest of violators. The form and content of the
- 11 summons or citation shall be as adopted or prescribed by the
- 12 administrative judge of the district courts and shall be printed
- 13 on a form commensurate with the form of other summonses or
- 14 citations used in modern methods of arrest, so designed to
- 15 include all necessary information to make the same valid within
- 16 the laws and regulations of the State."
- 17 SECTION 3. Section 291C-167, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 18 amended to read as follows:
- 19 "\$291C-167 Summons or citation on illegally parked
- 20 vehicle. Whenever any motor vehicle without a driver is found
- 21 parked or stopped in violation of any of the restrictions

- 1 contained in the state traffic laws, the officer or [designated
- 2 county employee] designee finding the vehicle shall take its
- 3 registration number and may take any other information displayed
- 4 on the vehicle that may identify its registered owner and
- 5 [conspicuously] shall conspicuously affix to the vehicle a
- 6 citation, as described in section 291C-165, for the registered
- 7 owner of record to answer as provided in chapter 291D."
- 8 SECTION 4. This Act does not affect rights and duties that
- 9 matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were
- 10 begun before its effective date.
- 11 SECTION 5. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 12 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 13 SECTION 6. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 3000.
