## A BILL FOR AN ACT

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 6E-2, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 2 amended by amending the definition of "historic property" to
- 3 read as follows:
- 4 ""Historic property" means any building[7] or structure[7]
- 5 that is registered on the Hawaii register of historic places, or
- 6 any object, district, area, or site, including heiau and
- 7 underwater site, [which-is over fifty years old.] that predates
- 8 August 21, 1959."
- 9 SECTION 2. This Act does not affect rights and duties that
- 10 matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were
- 11 begun before its effective date.
- 12 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 13 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 14 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
