A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO PUBLIC CHARTER SCHOOL PER-PUPIL FUNDING.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 302D-28, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows:

3 "(a) Beginning with fiscal year 2012-2013, and each fiscal
4 year thereafter, the non-facility general fund per-pupil funding
5 request for charter school students shall be the same as the
6 general fund per-pupil amount to the department in the most
7 recently approved executive budget recommendation for the
8 department and shall be based upon reasonable projected
9 enrollment figures for all charter schools. The general fund
10 per-pupil request for each regular education and special
11 education student shall:

12 (1) Include all general fund regular education cost
13 categories, including comprehensive school support
14 services, but excluding special education services,
15 adult education, [~~and~~] the after-school plus
16 program[+], and programs that provide comparable
17 benefits for all public school students regardless of


1 whether the student is a department school student or
2 a public charter school student; provided that these
3 services are provided and funded by the department;
4 and

5 (2) Exclude fringe benefit costs and debt service."

6 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
7 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

8 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2023.
