BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECT	ION 1. Chapter 171, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is	
2	amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated		
3	and to re	ad as follows:	
4	" <u>§17</u>	1- Wildfire safety advisory board. (a) There is	
5	establish	ed within the department the wildfire safety advisory	
6	board to	advise and make recommendations to state agencies	
7	concernin	g the state's wildfire safety and prevention efforts.	
8	(b)	The advisory board shall consist of the following	
9	members:		
10	(1)	The chairperson of the board of land and natural	
11		resources, or the chairperson's designee, who shall	
12		serve as chairperson of the advisory board;	
13	(2)	The chairperson of the state fire council, or the	
14		chairperson's designee;	
15	(3)	The director of the Hawaii emergency management	
16		agency, or the director's designee;	

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
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1	(4)	Two members who shall be appointed by the governor;
2	(5)	One member who shall be appointed by the president of
3		the senate; and
4	(6)	One member who shall be appointed by the speaker of
5		the house of representatives.
6	<u>(c)</u>	A member appointed to the advisory board by the
7	governor,	president of the senate, or speaker of the house of
8	represent	atives shall serve a four-year term.
9	<u>(d)</u>	The advisory board shall:
10	(1)	Develop and make recommendations related to wildfire
11		safety and mitigation performance metrics to state
12		agencies;
13	(2)	Create a state wildfire mitigation plan;
14	(3)	Manage and regularly update the state wildfire
15		mitigation plan;
16	(4)	Annually review a minimum of ten wildfire mitigation
17		plans and community wildfire protection plans to
18		determine if the plans substantially conform to or
19		exceed specified recommendations made by the Federal
20		Emergency Management Agency;



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1	(5)	Review and provide comments and advice to the public
2		utilities commission as part of the commission's
3		review and approval of an electric utility's wildfire
4		mitigation plan, as required by state law;
5	(6)	Provide other advice and recommendations related to
6		wildfire safety as may be requested by the division of
7		forestry and wildlife; and
8	(7)	Submit a report of its findings and recommendations,
9		including any proposed legislation, to the legislature
10		no later than twenty days prior to the convening of
11		the regular session for each odd numbered year.
12	<u>(e)</u>	The members of the advisory board shall serve without
13	compensat	ion but shall be reimbursed for expenses, including
14	travel ex	penses, necessary for the performance of their duties."
