### A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE TWENTIETH SENATORIAL DISTRICT.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The twentieth senatorial district encompasses
- 2 Ewa Beach, Ocean Pointe, Ewa By Gentry, Iroquois Point, and a
- 3 portion of Ewa Villages.
- 4 Accordingly, the purpose of this Act is to appropriate
- 5 funds for capital improvement projects in the twentieth
- 6 senatorial district.
- 7 SECTION 2. The director of finance is authorized to issue
- 8 general obligation bonds in the sum of \$105,920,000 or so much
- 9 thereof as may be necessary and the same sum or so much thereof
- 10 as may be necessary is appropriated for fiscal year 2024-2025
- 11 for the purpose of financing capital improvement projects for
- 12 the twentieth senatorial district, as follows:
- 13 1. To be expended by the department of transportation:
- 14 Fort Weaver road, Oahu
