## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO EXCESSIVE NOISE.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Act 63, Session Laws of Hawaii 2023, is amended
- by amending sections 1 and 2 to read as follows: 2
- 3 "SECTION 1. (a) The department of transportation, in
- 4 conjunction with any county having a population greater than
- 5 five hundred thousand, [shall develop and implement a pilot] may
- 6 establish a program to use noise detection traffic cameras to
- 7 address excessive traffic noise in urban areas of each
- 8 participating county.
- 9 The department of transportation shall submit a report
- 10 of its findings and recommendations, including any proposed
- 11 legislation, to the legislature no later than twenty days prior
- 12 to the convening of the regular session of 2025.
- 13 SECTION 2. [There is appropriated out of the state highway
- 14 fund the sum of \$2,500,000 or so much thereof as may be
- 15 necessary for fiscal year 2023 2024 and the same sum or so much
- 16 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2024 2025 for the
- 17 purposes of this Act. The sums appropriated shall be expended by



- 1 the department of transportation for the purposes of this Act.]
- 2 Repealed."
- 3 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 4 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 5 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on January 1, 2050.
