### A BILL FOR AN ACT

### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Chapter 127A, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated
3	and to read as follows:
4	" <u>§127A-</u> Wildfire-affected areas; prohibitions; safe
5	entry. (a) No person shall enter a wildfire-affected area for
6	the purpose of habitation until the department of health
7	provides public notice, in the manner prescribed in section
8	1-28.5, that the wildfire-affected area is safe to enter for
9	this purpose.
10	(b) As used in this section, "wildfire-affected area"
11	means a specific area that was affected by a wildfire that:
12	(1) Has been designated as toxic by the United States
13	Environmental Protection Agency; and
14	(2) Is subject to a debris removal program, including any
15	multi-phase program, to remove hazardous materials and
16	other fire debris,
