A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE DEPARTMENT OF LAW ENFORCEMENT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. In accordance with section 9 of article VII of
- 2 the Hawaii State Constitution and sections 37-91 and 37-93,
- 3 Hawaii Revised Statutes, the legislature has determined that the
- 4 appropriations contained in Act 164, Regular Session of 2023,
- 5 and this Act will cause the state general fund expenditure
- 6 ceiling for fiscal year 2024-2025 to be exceeded by
- 7 \$ or per cent. This current declaration takes
- 8 into account general fund appropriations authorized for fiscal
- 9 year 2024-2025 in Act 164, Regular Session of 2023, and this Act
- 10 only. The reasons for exceeding the general fund expenditure
- 11 ceiling are that:
- 12 (1) The appropriation made in this Act is necessary to
- serve the public interest; and
- 14 (2) The appropriation made in this Act meets the needs
- addressed by this Act.
- 16 SECTION 2. The following positions are established within
- 17 the department of law enforcement:

- (1) Eleven full-time equivalent (11.0 FTE) deputy sheriff
 positions; and
- 3 (2) Four full-time equivalent (4.0 FTE) permanent
- 4 supervisory deputy sheriff positions.
- 5 SECTION 3. There is appropriated out of the general
- 7 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2024-2025 for
- 8 an additional fifteen full-time equivalent (15.0 FTE) deputy
- 9 sheriff positions for law enforcement officer activities in
- 10 Lahaina and Maui.
- 11 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
- 12 law enforcement for the purposes of this Act.
- 13 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on January 1, 2042.
