BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. The department of human services shall amend
its rules, policies, and plan amendments to ensure that
medically necessary services, including applied behavior
analysis services, for eligible individuals aged twenty-one
years or older with neurodevelopmental disorders, including
autism spectrum disorder, are covered under the state's medical
program.

8 SECTION 2. In accordance with section 9 of article VII of 9 the Hawaii State Constitution and sections 37-91 and 37-93, 10 Hawaii Revised Statutes, the legislature has determined that the 11 appropriations contained in Act 164, Regular Session of 2023, 12 and this Act will cause the state general fund expenditure 13 ceiling for fiscal year 2024-2025 to be exceeded by 14 per cent.
