BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The purpose of this Act is to clarify and make
- 2 adjustments to part V of Act 46, Session Laws of Hawaii 2020,
- 3 based on data and information from the university of Hawaii at
- 4 Hilo college of Hawaiian language program.
- 5 SECTION 2. Act 46, Session Laws of Hawaii 2020, as amended
- 6 by section 9 of Act 210, Session Laws of Hawaii 2021, is amended
- 7 by amending section 16 to read as follows:
- 8 "SECTION 16. The standards, assessments, performance
- 9 ratings, staff qualifications, and staff training requirements
- 10 established by this Act shall not apply to any laboratory school
- 11 program of the Hawaiian language college at the university of
- 12 Hawaii at Hilo [until July 1, 2026]; provided that all child
- 13 care centers at any applicable college shall be licensed by the
- 14 department of human services prior to accepting children into
- 15 care."
- 16 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 17 and stricken.



1 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 3000.
