## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO BUDGET-RELATED SUBMISSIONS TO THE LEGISLATURE.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that legislative staff
- 2 spend weeks at the start of each legislative session
- 3 transcribing the proposed budgets of the executive branch,
- 4 judiciary branch, and office of Hawaiian affairs into a form
- 5 that is presentable to the public. This transcription may lead
- 6 to clerical, typographical, or other errors that obfuscate the
- 7 budgetary intentions. This process also consumes critical time
- 8 that could be better spent analyzing and contextualizing each
- 9 request in the proposed budget.
- 10 Accordingly, the purpose of this Act is to provide the
- 11 legislature with the authority to prescribe the forms of budget
- 12 requests for the executive branch, judiciary branch, and office
- 13 of Hawaiian affairs, similar to the authority provided to the
- 14 legislature by section 248-4, Hawaii Revised Statutes, to
- 15 prescribe the form of county budget requests.
- 16 SECTION 2. Section 10-14.5, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 17 amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows:



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         "(a)
               The budget, six-year program and financial plan, and
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    the variance report of the office of Hawaiian affairs shall be
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    submitted by the board to the legislature and to each member
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    thereof in accordance with the budget submission schedule
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    specified for the governor in chapter 37 and shall contain the
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    program information specified in that chapter that is applicable
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    to the office of Hawaiian affairs [-] in a form prescribed by the
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    legislature. Not less than twenty days prior to the convening
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    of each regular session of the legislature, the office of
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    Hawaiian affairs shall submit to the legislature an accounting
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    of the expenditures made in the prior fiscal year, by account
    code and budget program. By November 1 of each year preceding a
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    legislative session in which a budget is to be submitted, the
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    board shall provide written notification to the governor of the
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    proposed total expenditures, by cost categories and sources of
    funding, and estimated revenues of the office of Hawaiian
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    affairs for each fiscal year of the next fiscal biennium."
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                     Section 37-71, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
         SECTION 3.
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    amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows:
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         "(a) Not fewer than thirty days before the legislature
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    convenes in every odd-numbered year, the governor shall submit
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- 1 to the legislature and to each member thereof a budget that
  2 shall contain the program and budget recommendations of the
- 3 governor for the succeeding two fiscal years  $[\cdot]$  in a form
- 4 prescribed by the legislature. The budget, in general, shall
- 5 contain:
- 6 (1) The state program structure;
- 7 (2) Statements of statewide objectives;
- 8 (3) The financial requirements for the next two fiscal9 years to carry out the recommended programs; and
- 10 (4) A summary of state receipts and revenues in the last
  11 completed fiscal year, a revised estimate for the
  12 fiscal year in progress, and an estimate for the
  13 succeeding biennium."
- 14 SECTION 4. Section 37-72, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 15 amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows:
- "(a) Not fewer than thirty days before the legislature

  convenes in regular session in an even-numbered year, the

  governor may submit to the legislature a supplemental budget to

  amend any appropriation for the current fiscal biennium[-] in a

  form prescribed by the legislature. The supplemental budget
- 21 shall reflect the changes being proposed in the State's program

- 1 and financial plan and shall be submitted as applicable, in the
- 2 manner provided in section 37-71. In any supplemental budget
- 3 that proposes appropriations for which the source of funding is
- 4 general obligation bonds, the budget shall include the schedule,
- 5 declaration, and computation specified in section 37-71(d)(6)."
- 6 SECTION 5. Section 37-92, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 7 amended as follows:
- 8 1. By amending subsection (a) to read:
- 9 "(a) The governor shall submit a plan of proposed
- 10 appropriations for the State to the legislature which shall
- 11 accompany the state budget in odd-numbered years and the
- 12 supplemental budget in even-numbered years. The plan of
- 13 proposed appropriations shall be in a form prescribed by the
- 14 legislature and shall include the executive budget, proposed
- 15 grants to private entities, and any specific appropriation
- 16 measures to be proposed by the executive branch, and estimates
- 17 of the aggregate proposed appropriations of the judicial and
- 18 legislative branches of government. In any year in which the
- 19 plan of proposed appropriations from the general fund exceeds
- 20 the expenditure ceiling, the governor shall set forth the dollar
- 21 amount, the rate by which the expenditure ceiling would be

- 1 exceeded, and the reasons for proposing appropriations in excess
- 2 of those allowed under the expenditure ceiling."
- 3 2. By amending subsection (c) to read:
- 4 "(c) The governor shall submit a plan of proposed
- 5 appropriations for the executive branch to the legislature which
- 6 shall accompany the state budget in odd-numbered years and the
- 7 supplemental budget in even-numbered years. The plan of
- 8 proposed appropriations shall be in a form prescribed by the
- 9 legislature and shall include the executive budget, proposed
- 10 grants to private entities, and any specific appropriation
- 11 measures to be proposed by the executive branch."
- 12 3. By amending subsection (f) to read:
- "(f) The chief justice shall submit a plan of proposed
- 14 appropriations of the judicial branch to the legislature which
- 15 shall accompany the judiciary biennial budget in odd-numbered
- 16 years and the supplemental budget in even-numbered years. The
- 17 plan of proposed appropriations shall be in a form prescribed by
- 18 the legislature and shall include the judiciary budget, proposed
- 19 grants to private entities, and any specific appropriation
- 20 measures to be proposed by the judicial branch."

- 1 SECTION 6. The executive branch, judiciary branch, and
- 2 office of Hawaiian affairs shall conform to this Act no later
- 3 than December 1, 2023
- 4 SECTION 7. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 5 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 6 SECTION 8. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.

## Report Title:

OHA; Proposed Budget; Governor; Judiciary; Legislature

Authorizes the Legislature to specify the form in which the proposed budgets of the executive branch, judiciary branch, and Office of Hawaiian Affairs are submitted to the Legislature.
