BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. Section 196-41, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
 amended to read as follows:

3 "[+]\$196-41[+] State support for achieving renewable 4 energy projects and renewable portfolio standards. (a) The 5 department of land and natural resources and department of 6 business, economic development, and tourism shall facilitate the 7 private sector's development of renewable energy projects by 8 supporting the private sector's attainment of the renewable 9 portfolio standards in section 269-92. Both departments shall 10 provide meaningful support in areas relevant to the mission and 11 functions of each department as provided in this section, as 12 well as in other areas the directors of each department may deem 13 appropriate.

14 (b) The department of land and natural resources shall:
15 (1) Develop and publish a catalog by December 31, 2006,
16 and every five years thereafter, of potential sites
17 for the development of renewable energy; and
