BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. Section 342F-30.8, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
amended as follows:

3 1. By amending its title and subsection (a) to read:

"[{]§342F-30.8[}] Leaf blowers; weed whackers;

5 (a) In any urban land use district, as restrictions. designated pursuant to section 205-2, it shall be unlawful for 6 7 any person to operate a leaf blower or weed whacker within a 8 residential zone or within one hundred feet of a residential 9 zone in the State, except between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 10 6:00 p.m. on any day except Sunday or a state or federal 11 holiday, and between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m. on 12 Sunday or any state or federal holiday."

13 2. By amending subsections (d) and (e) to read:

14 "(d) Any county may adopt a rule or ordinance that places 15 stricter limitations on the use of leaf blowers <u>or weed whackers</u> 16 than are in this section. In case of a conflict between the 17 requirements or limitations of this section and any county rule


