A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO PROMOTING PORNOGRAPHY FOR MINORS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that there is a need for
- 2 increased ability to investigate and prosecute those who promote
- 3 pornography for minors. The legislature further finds that the
- 4 current offense of promoting pornography for minors does not
- 5 provide for undercover operations, and undercover operations
- 6 have proven to be an effective tool in reducing and combating
- 7 the offense and related sex trafficking offenses.
- 8 Accordingly, the purpose of this Act is to allow the
- 9 prosecution of a person who disseminates pornographic material
- 10 to undercover law enforcement officers who represent themselves
- 11 as minors under the offense of promoting pornography for minors.
- 12 SECTION 2. Section 712-1215, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 13 amended by amending subsection (1) to read as follows:
- 14 "(1) A person commits the offense of promoting pornography
- 15 for minors if:

1	(a)	Knowing	g its character and content, the person
2		dissemi	nates to a minor material [which] that is

4	(b)	Knowing its character and content, the person	
5		dissemi	nates material that is pornographic for minors
6		to a law enforcement officer who represents that	
7	•	officer's self as a minor; or	
8	[-(b) -]	(c) Knowing the character and content of a motion	
9		picture film or other performance [which,] that, in	
10	•	whole or in part, is pornographic for minors, the	
11		person:	
12		(i)	Exhibits [such] the motion picture film or
13			other performance to a minor;
14		(ii)	Sells to a minor an admission ticket or pass to
15			premises where there is exhibited or to be
16			exhibited [such] the motion picture film or
17			other performance; or
18		(iii)	Admits a minor to premises where there is
19			exhibited or to be exhibited [such] the motion
20			picture film or other performance."

- 1 SECTION 3. This Act does not affect rights and duties that
- 2 matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were
- 3 begun before its effective date.
- 4 SECTION 4. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 5 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 6 SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 3000.
