A BILL FOR AN ACT

MAKING AN EMERGENCY APPROPRIATION TO THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION FOR CHARTER SCHOOLS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. This Act is recommended by the governor for 2 immediate passage in accordance with article VII, section 9, of 3 the Constitution of the State of Hawaii. 4 SECTION 2. In accordance with section 9 of article VII of 5 the Hawaii State Constitution and sections 37-91 and 37-93, Hawaii Revised Statutes, the legislature has determined that the 6 7 general fund expenditure ceiling for fiscal year 2023-2024 has 8 already been exceeded by \$ per cent. The or 9 appropriations contained in this Act will cause the state 10 general fund expenditure ceiling for fiscal year 2023-2024 to be 11 further exceeded by \$ or per cent. This 12 declaration takes into account the additional general fund 13 appropriation authorized for fiscal year 2023-2024 in this Act 14 only. The reasons for exceeding the general fund expenditure 15 ceiling are that:

1	(1) The appropriations made in this Act are necessary to
2	serve the public interest; and
3	(2) The appropriations made in this Act meet the needs
4	addressed by this Act.
5	SECTION 3. The legislature finds that the department of
6	education is required pursuant to chapter 302D, Hawaii Revised
7	Statutes, to provide proportional funding to charter schools
8	based on their student enrollment. While the overall enrollment
9	for the department of education has increased for the 2023-2024
10	school year, the growth rate for public charter schools has
11	grown even faster, at four per cent higher than projected. One
12	factor that explains the sudden increased public charter school
13	enrollment is the growing need for temporary school options in
14	Lahaina as a result of the destruction caused by the devastating
15	August 2023 wildfires. As a result of the increased charter
16	school enrollment, the amount of funding for charter schools is
17	less than what is required.

18 Therefore, the purpose of this Act is to make an emergency 19 appropriation to the department of education to cover its 20 funding requirements for charter schools.

SECTION 4. There is appropriated out of the general
revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so
much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2023-2024 for
the department of education to provide funding for charter
schools.

6 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of7 education for the purposes of this Act.

8 SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 3000.
