A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO DOGS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 142-74, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 2 amended to read as follows:
- 3 "\$142-74 Liability of dog owner; penalty. (a) If any
- 4 dog, while on private property without the consent of the owner
- 5 of that property, injures or destroys any sheep, cattle, goat,
- $\mathbf{6}$ hog, fowl, or other property belonging to any person other than
- 7 the owner of the dog, the owner of the dog shall be liable in
- 8 damages to the person injured for the value of the property so
- 9 injured or destroyed. The owner of the dog shall confine or
- 10 destroy the dog, and if the owner of the dog neglects or refuses
- 11 to do so, the owner of the dog, in the event of any further
- 12 damage being done to the person or property of any person by the
- 13 dog, in addition to paying the person injured for the damage,
- 14 shall pay the costs of the trial together with the penalty
- 15 imposed under section 142-12, and it shall be lawful for any
- 16 other person to destroy the dog.

- 1 (b) If a violation under subsection (a) occurs while a dog
- 2 is on property zoned for agricultural use, the owner of the dog
- 3 shall be fined no less than \$1,000 in addition to the penalties
- 4 imposed under subsection (a).
- 5 [\(\frac{(b)}{}\)] (c) Each county may enact and enforce ordinances
- 6 regulating persons who own, harbor, or keep any dog that has
- 7 injured, maimed, or destroyed an animal belonging to another
- 8 person. No ordinance enacted [under] pursuant to this
- 9 subsection shall be held invalid on the ground that it covers
- 10 any subject or matter embraced within any statute or rule of the
- 11 State; provided that the ordinance shall not affect the civil
- 12 liability of a person owning, harboring, or keeping the dog.
- 13 Upon enactment of an ordinance, whether enacted on, before, or
- 14 after June 30, 2001, the ordinance shall have full force and
- 15 effect; provided that the ordinance is consistent with this
- 16 section."
- 17 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 18 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 19 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on June 30, 3000.
