A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO EDUCATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. Section 26-52, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
amended to read as follows:

3 "§26-52 Department heads and executive officers. The 4 salaries of the following state officers shall be as follows: 5 (1)The salary of the superintendent of education shall be 6 set by the board of education [at a rate no greater 7 than \$250,000 a year]. The superintendent shall be 8 subject to an annual performance evaluation that is in 9 alignment with other employee evaluations within the 10 department of education and are based on outcomes 11 determined by the board of education; provided that 12 nothing shall prohibit the board of education from 13 conditioning a portion of the salary on performance; 14 (2)The salary of the president of the [University] 15 university of Hawaii shall be set by the board of 16 regents;

17 (3) Effective July 1, 2004, the salaries of all department

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

10	prior to June 30, 2024, shall remain in effect for the duration
11	of the contract]."
12	SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
13	and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
14	SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on June 29, 2024.
