BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 91-13.5, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 2 amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows:
- 3 "(a) Unless otherwise provided by law, an agency shall
- 4 adopt rules that specify a maximum time period to grant or deny
- 5 a business or development-related permit, license, or approval;
- 6 provided that the maximum time period shall only apply if a
- 7 request for a contested case has not been filed; provided
- 8 further that the application [is] shall not be subject to state
- 9 administered permit programs delegated, authorized, or approved
- 10 under federal law."
- 11 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 12 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 3000.
