A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO PERSONS WITH DISABILITIES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTIO	DN 1. Chapter 346, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is	
2	amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated		
3	and to read as follows:		
4	" <u>§346-</u>	Medicaid buy-in program for workers with	
5	disabilitie	(a) The department shall adopt the option made	
6	available u	under section 1902(a)(10)(A)(ii)(XIII) of the federal	
7	Social Security Act.		
8	(d)_	To be eligible for benefits under this section, an	
9	individual shall:		
10	<u>(1)</u>	Have a net countable income greater than two hundred	
11	<u>f</u>	fifty per cent of the federal poverty level for one	
12	<u>F</u>	person or, if the deeming of spousal income applies to	
13	<u>t</u>	the individual, the individual shall have a net	
14	<u>C</u>	countable income greater than two hundred fifty per	
15	<u>c</u>	cent of the federal poverty level for two persons;	
16	<u>(2)</u> <u>E</u>	Be disabled under title II or XVI or section 1902(v)	
17	C	of the federal Social Security Act; provided that an	

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1		individual shall be determined to be eligible under	
2		this section without regard to the individual's	
3		ability to engage in, or actual engagement in,	
4		substantial gainful activity, as defined in section	
5		223(d)(4) of the federal Social Security Act; and	
6	(3)	Except as otherwise provided in this section, have net	
7		nonexempt resources, which shall be determined in	
8		accordance with the methodology used under title XVI	
9		of the federal Social Security Act, that are not in	
10		excess of the limits provided for under those	
11		provisions.	
12	Coun	table income shall be determined under section 1612 of	
13	the feder	al Social Security Act, except that the individual's	
14	disabilit	y income, including all federal and state disability	
15	benefits and private disability insurance, shall be exempted.		
16	Resources excluded under section 1613 of the federal Social		
17	Security	Act shall be disregarded.	
18	Reso	urces in the form of employer or individual retirement	
19	arrangements authorized under the Internal Revenue Code shall be		
20	exempted as authorized by section 1902(r) of the federal Social		
21	Security Act.		



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1	(c)	Individuals eligible for benefits under this section
2	shall be	subject to the payment of premiums determined under
3	this subs	ection. The department shall:
4	(1)	Establish sliding-scale premiums that are based on
5		countable income, with a minimum premium of \$20 per
6		month and a maximum premium of \$250 per month; and
7	(2)	By rule, annually adjust the premiums.
8	Before ad	justment of any premiums determined pursuant to this
9	subsectio	n, the department shall submit a report of proposed
10	premium a	djustments to the legislature no later than twenty days
11	prior to	the convening of each regular session.
12	(d)	In order to implement the collection of premiums under
13	this sect	ion, the department may:
14	(1)	Develop and execute a contract with a public or
15		private entity to collect premiums; or
16	(2)	Amend any existing or future premium-collection
17		contract that it has executed.
18	(e)	The department shall adopt rules pursuant to
19	chapter 9	1 necessary for the purposes of this section, including
20	specifyin	g the process for discontinuance of eligibility under

- 1 this section for nonpayment of premiums for more than two months
- 2 by a beneficiary.
- 3 (f) Notwithstanding any other provision of law, this
- 4 section shall be implemented only if, and to the extent that,
- 5 the department determines that federal financial participation
- 6 is available pursuant to title XIX of the federal Social
- 7 Security Act."
