A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE
THIRD SENATORIAL DISTRICT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The director of finance is authorized to issue
2 general obligation bonds in the sum of \$246,708,361 or so much
3 thereof as may be necessary and the same sum or so much thereof
4 as may be necessary is appropriated for fiscal year 2024-2025
5 for the purpose of capital improvement projects for the third
6 senatorial district, as follows:

9 SECTION 2. The appropriation made for the capital
10 improvement project authorized by this Act shall not lapse at
11 the end of the fiscal biennium for which the appropriation is
12 made; provided that all moneys from the appropriation
13 unencumbered as of June 30, 2026, shall lapse as of that date.

14 SECTION 3. The sums appropriated for the respective
15 capital improvement projects set forth in section 1 shall be
16 expended for the purposes of this Act as follows:

17 (1) The sum appropriated in item 1, items 3 and 4, and
18 items 6 through 16 shall be expended by the department
19 of education;


20 (2) The sum appropriated in items 2 and 5 shall be
21 expended by the Hawaii health systems corporation;



- 1 (3) The sum appropriated in items 17 and 18 shall be
- 2 expended by the department of transportation;
- 3 (4) The sum appropriated in items 19, 21, and 22 shall be
- 4 expended by the department of land and natural
- 5 resources;
- 6 (5) The sum appropriated in item 20 shall be expended by
- 7 the department of health; and
- 8 (6) The sum appropriated in item 23 shall be expended by
- 9 the county of Hawaii; provided that the county of
- 10 Hawaii provides matching funds on a dollar-to-dollar
- 11 basis.

12 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2024.
