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# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE  
NINETEENTH SENATORIAL DISTRICT.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1           SECTION 1. The director of finance is authorized to issue  
2 general obligation bonds in the sum of \$275,165,589 or so much  
3 thereof as may be necessary, and the same sum or so much thereof  
4 as may be necessary is appropriated for fiscal year 2024-2025  
5 for the purpose of capital improvement projects for the  
6 nineteenth senatorial district, as follows:

7     1.     Pearl City High School

8           A.     Construction of an integrated  
9                   academy, multi-use facility shared  
10                  between Pearl City high school and  
11                  Momilani elementary school.

12 SECTION 2. The appropriations made for the capital  
13 improvement projects authorized by this Act shall not lapse at  
14 the end of the fiscal year for which the appropriations are  
15 made; provided that all moneys from the appropriations that are  
16 unencumbered as of June 30, 2026, shall lapse as of that date.

17 SECTION 3. The sums appropriated for the respective  
18 capital improvement projects set forth in section 1 shall be  
19 expended for the purposes of this Act as follows:

20 (1) The sums appropriated in items 1 through 13 shall be  
21 expended by the department of education; and



1 (2) The sum appropriated in item 14 shall be expended by  
2 the department of accounting and general services.

3 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2024.
