A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CESSPOOLS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 342D-72, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 2 amended to read as follows:
- 3 "\$342D-72 Cesspools; mandatory upgrade, conversion, or
- 4 connection. (a) Before January 1, 2050, every cesspool in the
- 5 State, excluding cesspools granted [exemptions] an exemption by
- 6 the director of health pursuant to subsection (b) [-7] or (c),
- 7 shall be:
- 8 (1) Upgraded or converted to a director-approved
- 9 wastewater system; or
- 10 (2) Connected to a sewerage system.
- 11 (b) The director of health may grant [exemptions] an
- 12 exemption from the requirements of subsection (a) [to] if the
- 13 State is unable to present evidence that the cesspool is
- 14 affecting the State's drinking water supply or recreational
- 15 waters.
- 16 (c) The director of health may also grant an exemption
- 17 from the requirements of subsection (a) if a property [owners of

- 1 cesspools that apply owner applies for an exemption and
- 2 [present] presents documentation showing a legitimate reason
- 3 that makes it infeasible to upgrade, convert, or connect the
- 4 [cesspools.] cesspool. For the purposes of this subsection, a
- 5 legitimate reason shall include but not be limited to:
- 6 (1) Small lot size;
- 7 (2) Steep topography;
- 8 (3) Poor soils; or
- 9 (4) Accessibility issues.
- 10 $[\frac{(c)}{(c)}]$ (d) As used in this section, "cesspool" means an
- 11 individual wastewater system consisting of an excavation in the
- 12 ground whose depth is greater than its widest surface dimension,
- 13 that receives untreated wastewater, and retains or is designed
- 14 to retain the organic matter and solids discharged into it, but
- 15 permits the liquid to seep through its bottom or sides to gain
- 16 access to the underground geographic formation."
- 17 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 18 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
