BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:



19 SECTION 12. There is appropriated out of federal moneys 20 received by the State of Hawaii the sum of \$130,000 or so much 21 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2024-2025 for the

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1 rehabilitation of Waipuilani stream, including installation of 2 irrigation from the R-1 water reservoir and planting of 3 vegetation to trap sediment. The sum appropriated shall be expended by the clean water 4 5 branch of the department of health for the purposes of this 6 part. 7 PART VI 8 SECTION 13. The appropriations made by this Act shall not 9 lapse at the end of the fiscal year for which the appropriation 10 is made; provided that all moneys from the appropriation 11 unencumbered as of June 30, 2026, shall lapse as of that date. 12 SECTION 14. In accordance with section 9 of article VII of 13 the Hawaii State Constitution and sections 37-91 and 37-93, 14 Hawaii Revised Statutes, the legislature has determined that the 15 appropriations contained in Act 164, Regular Session of 2023, and this Act will cause the state general fund expenditure 16 17 ceiling for fiscal year 2024-2025 to be exceeded by 18 per cent. This current declaration takes \$ or 19 into account general fund appropriations authorized for fiscal 20 year 2024-2025 in Act 164, Regular Session of 2023, and this Act

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1	only. The reasons for exceeding the general fund expenditure
2	ceiling are that:
3	(1) The appropriation made in this Act is necessary to
4	serve the public interest; and
5	(2) The appropriation made in this Act meets the needs
6	addressed by this Act.
