A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO HAWAII COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 206E-14, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows:

3 "(a) The authority may, without recourse to public
4 auction, sell, or lease for a term not exceeding [~~sixty-five~~
5 ninety-nine years, except that leases for ceded lands shall have
6 a term not exceeding sixty-five years, all or any portion of the
7 real or personal property constituting a redevelopment project
8 to any person, upon such terms and conditions as may be approved
9 by the authority, if the authority finds that the sale or lease
10 is in conformity with the community development plan.

11 For the stadium development district, leases shall not
12 exceed a term of ninety-nine years."

13 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
14 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

15 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
