A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO PAID SICK LEAVE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. (a) The department of labor and industrial
- 2 relations shall conduct a study on the implementation of a state
- 3 program that requires employers to provide a minimum amount of
- 4 paid sick leave to employees and supplemental paid sick leave to
- 5 employees with a focus on the effects of mandatory paid sick
- 6 leave on small businesses and low-income employees.
- 7 (b) The study shall consider the federal Fair Labor
- 8 Standards Act, Hawaii Prepaid Health Care Act, and various
- 9 federal and state laws on health benefits, temporary disability,
- 10 and workers compensation with the purpose of providing sick
- 11 leave to all employees, as defined in section 398-1, Hawaii
- 12 Revised Statutes, including the coverage of employers and
- 13 employees not covered by collective bargaining units.
- 14 (c) The department of labor and industrial relations shall
- 15 invite the following organizations to participate in the study:
- 16 (1) Hawaii Restaurant Association;
- 17 (2) Retail Merchants of Hawaii:



- 1 (3) UNITE HERE Local 5; 2 (4) Hawaii Children's A
- 2 (4) Hawaii Children's Action Network Speaks!;
- 3 (5) Hawaii Workers Center; and
- 4 (6) Any other employer, representative, or agency deemed
- 5 appropriate by the department of labor and industrial
- 6 relations.
- 7 (d) The department of labor and industrial relations shall
- 8 submit a report of its findings and recommendations, including
- 9 any proposed legislation, to the legislature no later than
- 10 twenty days prior to the convening of the regular session of
- 11 2024.
- 12 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
- 13 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so
- 14 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2023-2024 and
- 15 the same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal
- 16 year 2024-2025 for the department of labor and industrial
- 17 relations to conduct the study on paid sick leave and prepare
- 18 the report to the legislature as required by section 1 of this
- 19 Act.
- The sums appropriated shall be expended by the department
- 21 of labor and industrial relations for the purposes of this Act.

1 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on January 1, 2050.
