A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO SPECIAL LICENSE PLATES FOR IRAQ AND AFGHANISTAN WAR VETERANS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 249-9.2, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 2 amended by amending subsections (a) and (b) to read as follows:
- 3 "(a) In lieu of the number plates contracted on behalf of
- 4 the counties by the director of finance of the city and county
- 5 of Honolulu, the director of finance shall provide, for a fee,
- 6 one set of special number plates upon the receipt of an
- 7 application together with:
- 8 (1) Specific proof that the applicant was awarded the
 9 Purple Heart by the United States Department of
 10 Defense for wounds received in military or naval
- 11 combat against an armed enemy of the United States;
- (2) Certification that the applicant is a veteran;
- 13 (3) Specific proof that the applicant was serving the
- 14 United States in the military or as a civilian, on
- 15 Oahu, or offshore at a distance of not more than three
- 16 miles at the time of the December 7, 1941, attack on

1		Pearl Harbor. Certification from the Hawaii state
2		chairperson of the Pearl Harbor Survivors Association
3		shall constitute sufficient proof;
4	(4)	Specific proof that the applicant was confined as a
5		prisoner of war while providing military service to
6		the United States;
7	(5)	Certification from the United States Department of
8		Veterans Affairs or the state office of veterans'
9		services that the applicant is a combat veteran or a
10		veteran of the Vietnam conflict, the Korean conflict,
11		World War II, $[\Theta r]$ the Persian Gulf conflict $[rac{+}]$, the
12		Iraq conflict, or the Afghanistan conflict; or
13	(6)	Specific proof that the applicant would qualify for a
14		gold star lapel button under the criteria established
15		by title 10 United States Code section 1126; provided
16		that the applicant shall not be disqualified for the
17		special number plates because the applicant is the
18		grandparent of the deceased member of the United
19		States armed forces;
20	provided	that applicants, except civilian applicants under
21	paragraph	(3) and civilian applicants and applicants who are

1 currently serving the United States in the military under paragraph (6), shall also provide a copy of the applicant's most 2 recent discharge paper or separation document that indicates an 3 honorable discharge or general (under honorable conditions) 4 5 discharge from active duty. 6 The design of the plates for: (b) 7 Purple heart recipients shall include the words (1) "COMBAT WOUNDED"; 8 Veterans shall include the word "VETERAN"; 9 (2) 10 Pearl Harbor survivors shall include the words "PEARL (3) 11 HARBOR SURVIVOR"; Former prisoners of war shall include the words 12 (4) 13 "FORMER PRISONER OF WAR"; 14 (5) Combat veterans shall include the words "COMBAT VETERAN"; 15 Veterans of the Vietnam conflict shall include the 16 (6) 17 words "VIETNAM VETERAN"; (7) Veterans of the Korean conflict shall include the 18 words "KOREA VETERAN"; 19 Veterans of World War II shall include the words 20 (8) 21 "WORLD WAR II VETERAN";

1	(9)	Veterans of the Persian Gulf conflict shall include
2		the words "PERSIAN GULF VETERAN"; [and]
3	(10)	Veterans of the Iraq conflict shall include the words
4		"IRAQ VETERAN";
5	(11)	Veterans of the Afghanistan conflict shall include the
6		words "AFGHANISTAN VETERAN"; and
7	[(10)]	(12) Gold star family members, including grandparents,
8		shall include the words "GOLD STAR FAMILY".
9	These designations shall be imprinted on the left side of	
10	the license plates in a manner similar to congressional and	
11	honorary consul license plates."	
12	SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed	
13	and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.	
14	SECT	ION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
