BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Chapter 142, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended by adding a new section to part IV to be appropriately
3	designated and to read as follows:
4	" <u>§142-</u> Marine mammals; commercial performances;
5	prohibited. (a) No person shall promote, arrange, conduct,
6	assist in, receive money for, or take part in any meeting,
7	competition, exhibition, pastime, practice, display, or event at
8	or in the course of which a captive marine mammal is used for
9	performance for entertainment purposes.
10	(b) This section shall not be construed to prohibit a
11	person from holding a marine mammal for research or
12	rehabilitation purposes.
13	(c) As used in this section, "marine mammal" includes monk

- 14 seals and any species within the cetacean order, including
- 15 whales, dolphins, and porpoises."

SECTION 2. This Act does not affect rights and duties that
matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were
begun before its effective date.
