RELATING TO THE PUBLIC UTILITIES COMMISSION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Chapter 269, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 2 amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated
- 3 and to read as follows:
- 4 "S269- Reports to the public utilities commission;
- 5 expiration. Any reporting requirement established by the public
- 6 utilities commission through an order and is not provided for in
- 7 this chapter or any other statute shall expire one year after
- 8 the issuance of the order; provided that the public utilities
- 9 commission may issue a new order allowing for the continuation
- 10 of the reporting requirement; provided further that the new
- 11 order shall provide justification for the continuation of the
- 12 reporting requirement."
- 13 SECTION 2. New statutory material is underscored.
- 14 SECTION 3 This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
