# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO AGRICULTURE.

### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that as the demand for unskilled labor increases, farmers and ranchers are searching 2 for ways to use technology to better operate their farms. 3 The 4 legislature further finds that certain foreign technology, like 5 small equipment tractors from Japan, could be greatly beneficial to farmers and ranchers. However, this type of equipment cannot 6 be imported because it does not comply with the United States 7 8 Environmental Protection Agency's emission standards for small 9 engines.

10 The purpose of this Act is to benefit farmers and ranchers 11 in the State by appropriating funds to the University of Hawaii 12 to establish a foreign agriculture small equipment pilot program 13 to identify and purchase foreign agricultural technology, 14 including small equipment tractors, and retrofit engines to 15 comply with the United States Environmental Protection Agency's 16 emission standards for small engines.

1	SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
2	revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so
3	much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2023-2024 and

5	year 2024-2025 to establish the foreign agriculture small
6	equipment pilot program at a community college selected by the
7	University of Hawaii, to identify and purchase foreign

11	The sums appropriated shall be expended by the University
