A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO GAMBLING.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Chapter 712, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated
3	and to read as follows:
4	"§712- Operation of illegal gambling businesses. (1)
5	person commits the offense of operating an illegal gambling
6	business if the person conducts; finances, manages, supervises,
7	directs, or owns all or part of an illegal gambling business.
8	(2) For purposes of this section, "illegal gambling
9	business" means a business that:
10	(a) Advances gambling activity in violation of this part;
11	(b) Involves five or more persons who conduct, finance,
12	manage, supervise, direct, or own all or part of the
13	business; and
14	(c) Has been or remains in substantially continuous
15	operation for a period in excess of thirty days or has
16	a gross revenue in excess of \$2,000 in any single day.

- 1 (3) Any property, including real property, gambling
- 2 devices, paraphernalia used on fighting animals, or birds,
- 3 implements, furniture, personal property, vehicles, vessels,
- 4 aircraft, or gambling record possessed or used in violation of
- 5 this section, or any money or personal property used as a bet or
- 6 stake in gambling activity in violation of this section, may be
- 7 ordered forfeited to the State, subject to the requirements of
- 8 chapter 712A.
- 9 (4) Operation of an illegal gambling business is a class C
- 10 felony."
- 11 SECTION 2. This Act does not affect rights and duties that
- 12 matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were
- 13 begun before its effective date.
- 14 SECTION 3. New statutory material is underscored.
- 15 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on March 22, 2075.
