A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO AQUACULTURE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The department of agriculture shall (a) 2 conduct a feasibility study to identify potential sites in the 3 State for an aquaculture park that promotes commercial aquaculture expansion. The study shall consider factors, 4 5 including but not limited to the following: 6 The plans and designs of the proposed aquaculture park (1)7 that supports commercial aquaculture operations; 8 Any zoning requirements, building codes, and existing (2)9 conditions of each potential site, including any 10 easements and property disputes; 11 (3) The current usage of neighboring property and any 12 potential environmental impacts of establishing an 13 aquacultural park at each potential site; Any variance, permit, or approval necessary to 14 (4)15 establish an aquaculture park at each potential site; 16 and

1 (5) A projected budget and timeline for the construction of the agricultural park at each potential site. 2 The department of agriculture shall submit a report of 3 (b) its findings and recommendations, including any proposed 4 5 legislation, resulting from the feasibility study to identify potential sites in the State for an aquacultural park to the 6 legislature no later than twenty days prior to the convening of 7 8 the regular session of 2024. SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general 9 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ 10 or so 11 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2023-2024 and 12 the same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal 13 year 2024-2025 for the department of agriculture to conduct a 14 feasibility study that identifies potential sites in the State for an aquaculture park that promotes commercial aquaculture 15 16 expansion. The sums appropriated shall be expended by the department 17 of agriculture for the purposes of this Act. 18
