## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO AGRICULTURE.

### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECT	ION 1. Chapter 141, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is	
2	amended by adding a new section to part I to be appropriately		
3	designate	d and to read as follows:	
4	"§141- Healthy soils program; established. (a) The		
5	departmen	t of agriculture shall establish a healthy soils	
6	program.	The healthy soils program shall:	
7	(1)	Create a statewide soil health assessment with a list	
8		of practices specific to the State and that are most	
9		effective in improving soil health and building soil	
10		carbon stocks;	
11	(2)	Provide farmers with education and technical	
12		assistance to implement farm management practices that	
13		contribute to healthy soils;	
14	(3)	Establish standards that apply to the healthy soils	
15		program and are based on the findings of the	
16		greenhouse gas sequestration task force established	
17		pursuant to section 225P-4 relating to minimum levels	

1		of soil carbon and water content and required soil
2		health practices;
3	(4)	Establish standards for soil health to include the
4		importance of a holistic approach to land management
5		that integrates cultural, biological, and mechanical
6		practices, which cycle nutrients, promote ecological
7		balance, and conserve biodiversity;
8	(5)	Establish standards that phase out the use of
9		petrochemical synthetic fertilizers over a period of
10		five to ten years; provided that during the
11		petrochemical synthetic fertilizer phase-out period,
12		the department of agriculture shall provide farmers
13		with assistance in adopting a holistic approach to
14		land management that integrates cultural, biological,
15		and mechanical practices, which cycle nutrients,
16		promote ecological balance, and conserve biodiversity
17		and the state of t
18	(6)	Subject to available funding, issue awards and other
19		financial incentives to implement farm management
20		practices that contribute to healthy soils.

1	(b)	The long-term goals of the healthy soils program shall
2	be to est	ablish:
3	(1)	Deadlines by which all awards issued by the department
4		of agriculture shall meet the standards established
5		pursuant to subsection (a)(3);
6	(2)	Deadlines by which a plan for all state lands leased
7		for agricultural use shall be required; and
8	(3)	Programs incentivizing small farmers, ranchers, and
9		landowners to take carbon negative actions on their
10		respective lands.
11	(c)	The department of agriculture shall submit a report
12	detailing	the status and progress of the healthy soils program
13	and its r	ecommendations, including any proposed legislation, to
14	the legis	lature no later than twenty days prior to the convening
15	of each r	egular session."
16	SECT	ION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
17	revenues	of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$500,000 or so much
18	thereof a	s may be necessary for fiscal year 2023-2024 and the
19	same sum	or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year
20	2024-2025	for the establishment of the healthy soils program and

- 1 to issue awards and other financial incentives pursuant to the
- 2 program.
- 3 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the department
- 4 of agriculture for the purposes of this Act.
- 5 SECTION 3. New statutory material is underscored.
- 6 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2023.
