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# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO INTOXICATING LIQUOR.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1           SECTION 1. Section 281-31, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is  
2 amended by amending subsection (r) to read as follows:

3           "(r) Class 18. Small craft producer pub license. A small  
4 craft producer pub licensee:

5           (1) Shall manufacture in the State not more than:

6           (A) [~~Seventy~~] One hundred fifty thousand barrels of  
7 malt beverages;

8           (B) [~~Twenty~~] Thirty thousand barrels of wine; or

9           (C) [~~Seven~~] Ten thousand [~~five hundred~~] barrels of  
10 alcohol on the licensee's premises during the  
11 license year;

12 provided that for purposes of this paragraph, "barrel"  
13 means a container not exceeding thirty-one gallons or  
14 wine gallons of liquor;

15           (2) May sell malt beverages, wine, or alcohol manufactured  
16 on the licensee's premises for consumption on the  
17 premises;



- 1 (3) May sell malt beverages, wine, or alcohol manufactured  
2 by the licensee in producer-sealed packages to class 3  
3 wholesale dealer licensees pursuant to conditions  
4 imposed by the county by ordinance or rule;
- 5 (4) May sell intoxicating liquor purchased from a class 3  
6 wholesale dealer licensee to consumers for consumption  
7 on the licensee's premises. The categories of  
8 establishments shall be as follows:
- 9 (A) A standard bar; or
- 10 (B) Premises in which live entertainment or recorded  
11 music is provided. Facilities for dancing by the  
12 patrons may be permitted as provided by  
13 commission rules;
- 14 (5) May, subject to federal labeling and bottling  
15 requirements, sell malt beverages manufactured on the  
16 licensee's premises to consumers in producer-sealed  
17 kegs and recyclable or reusable containers and sell  
18 malt beverages manufactured on the licensee's premises  
19 or purchased from a class 1 manufacturer licensee, a  
20 class 3 wholesale dealer licensee, a class 14 brewpub  
21 licensee, or a class 18 small craft producer pub



1 licensee to consumers in growlers for off-premises  
2 consumption; provided that for purposes of this  
3 paragraph, "growler" means a recyclable or reusable  
4 container that does not exceed one gallon, which shall  
5 be securely sealed;

6 (6) May, subject to federal labeling and bottling  
7 requirements, sell wine or alcohol manufactured on the  
8 licensee's premises in recyclable containers provided  
9 by the licensee or by the consumer which do not  
10 exceed:

11 (A) One gallon per container for wine; and

12 (B) One liter for alcohol; and

13 are securely sealed on the licensee's premises to  
14 consumers for off-premises consumption;

15 (7) Shall comply with all requirements pertaining to class  
16 4 retail dealer licensees when engaging in the retail  
17 sale of malt beverages, wine, and alcohol;

18 (8) May, subject to federal labeling and bottling  
19 requirements, sell malt beverages, wine, and alcohol  
20 manufactured on the licensee's premises in producer-  
21 sealed containers directly to class 2 restaurant



1 licensees, class 3 wholesale dealer licensees, class 4  
2 retail dealer licensees, class 5 dispenser licensees,  
3 class 6 club licensees, class 8 transient vessel  
4 licensees, class 9 tour or cruise vessel licensees,  
5 class 10 special licensees, class 11 cabaret  
6 licensees, class 12 hotel licensees, class 13 caterer  
7 licensees, class 14 brewpub licensees, class 15  
8 condominium hotel licensees, class 18 small craft  
9 producer pub licensees, and consumers pursuant to  
10 conditions imposed by county ordinances or rules  
11 governing class 1 manufacturer licensees and class 3  
12 wholesale dealer licensees;

13 (9) May conduct the activities under paragraphs (1) to (8)  
14 at locations other than the licensee's premises;  
15 provided that:

16 (A) The manufacturing takes place in Hawaii;

17 (B) Each of the other locations:

18 (i) Operates within the State under the same  
19 trade name for the premises; and

20 (ii) Is properly licensed within the county of  
21 its operation as a class 1 manufacturer



1                   licensee, class 2 restaurant licensee, class  
2                   4 retail dealer licensee, class 5 dispenser  
3                   licensee, class 12 hotel licensee, class 14  
4                   brewpub licensee, or class 18 small craft  
5                   producer pub licensee;

6                   (C) The county liquor commission of the county in  
7                   which the licensee satellite is located shall  
8                   have jurisdiction of the satellite; and

9                   (D) All requirements of the license class of the  
10                  location shall be in effect as required by the  
11                  county liquor commission for the satellite  
12                  licensed premises; and

13                 (10) May allow minors, who are accompanied by a parent or  
14                 legal guardian of legal drinking age, on the  
15                 licensee's premises."

16                 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed  
17                 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

18                 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2050.
