A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO AGRICULTURE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECT	ION 1. (a) There is established an agricultural				
2	facilitie	s task force to be placed in the office of planning and				
3	sustainable development.					
4	(b)	The task force shall consist of the following members:				
5	(1)	The director of the office of planning and sustainable				
6		development, or the director's designee, who shall				
7		serve as the chairperson of the task force;				
8	(2)	The chairperson of the board of agriculture; or the				
9		chairperson's designee;				
10	(3)	The deputy director of the department of				
11		transportation, harbors division, or the deputy				
12		director's designee;				
13	(4)	The deputy director of the department of				
14		transportation, airports division, or the deputy				
15		director's designee;				
16	(5)	The director of business, economic development, and				
17		tourism, or the director's designee:

- 7 (c) The task force shall:
- 8 (1) Create a master plan for agricultural facilities at
 9 ports of transportation for the purpose of moving
 10 commodities to market. The agricultural facilities
 11 shall include slaughter and value-adding facilities
 12 and cold storage and value-adding facilities for
 13 plants; and
- 14 (2) Have the authority to seek the services of special
 15 advisors to provide data and research for the
 16 development of the master plan.
- (d) The task force shall submit a report of its findings and recommendations, including any proposed legislation, to the legislature no later than twenty days prior to the convening of the regular session of 2024.
- 21 (e) The task force shall dissolve on December 31, 2025.

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SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so
much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2023-2024 and
the same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal
year 2024-2025 for the establishment of a task force to create a
master plan for agricultural facilities at ports of
transportation for the purpose of moving commodities to market.
The sums appropriated shall be expended by the office of
planning and sustainable development for the purposes of this
Act.
SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval;
provided that section 2 shall take effect on July 1, 2023.
