A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO GENDER PARITY IN PROGRAMS FOR INCARCERATED WOMEN.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that section 367D-1,
- 2 Hawaii Revised Statutes, requires parity in the programming
- 3 offered to women and men incarcerated in the State's
- 4 correctional facilities. More specifically, section 367D-1,
- 5 Hawaii Revised Statutes, provides that female prisoners "shall
- 6 be provided a range and quality of programming substantially
- 7 equivalent to the range and quality of programming offered to
- 8 male persons who are similarly situated." These programs
- 9 include educational development, job training, substance abuse
- 10 and cognitive-behavioral treatment services, and cultural
- 11 practices.
- The legislature further finds that, based on the
- 13 information provided in the department of public safety's
- 14 December 2021 report to the legislature on gender responsive
- 15 community based programs for women, parity does not appear to
- 16 exist with respect to the range and quality of programming that
- 17 is currently available to female and male inmates in the State.

- 1 The purpose of this Act is to appropriate funds to the
- 2 Hawaii Friends of Restorative Justice as a grant to conduct a
- 3 study of programming offered to persons incarcerated at
- 4 correctional facilities and convene a group of incarcerated
- 5 women for the purpose of identifying gaps in programming offered
- 6 to female inmates.
- 7 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
- 8 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so
- 9 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2023-2024 as a
- 10 grant pursuant to chapter 42F, Hawaii Revised Statutes, to the
- 11 Hawaii Friends of Restorative Justice to conduct a study of
- 12 programming offered to persons incarcerated at correctional
- 13 facilities and convene a group of incarcerated women to help
- 14 identify gaps in programming offered to female inmates; provided
- 15 that the Hawaii Friends of Restorative Justice shall use the
- 16 report of the task force convened by House Concurrent Resolution
- 17 No. 85, Regular Session of 2016, as a model to provide
- 18 recommendations to improve outcomes for incarcerated women;
- 19 provided further that the Hawaii Friends of Restorative Justice
- 20 shall consult with the interagency council on intermediate
- 21 sanctions and correctional program checklist committee when

- 1 conducting the study and making recommendations to improve
- 2 outcomes for incarcerated women; provided further that the
- 3 Hawaii Friends of Restorative Justice shall submit the study,
- 4 including any proposed legislation, to the legislature no later
- 5 than June 30, 2024.
- 6 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on June 30, 3000.

Hawaii Friends of Restorative Justice; Corrections; Inmates; Programming; Gender Parity; Study; Appropriation

Description:

Appropriates funds to the Hawaii Friends of Restorative Justice as a grant to conduct a study of all programming offered to persons incarcerated at correctional facilities and convene a group of incarcerated women for the purpose of identifying gaps in programming offered to female inmates. Requires that the study be submitted to the Legislature by 6/30/2024. Effective 6/30/3000. (HD1)

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
