A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO PUBLIC EMPLOYEES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that collective
- 2 bargaining unit (5) includes public charter school teachers and
- 3 other personnel employed by public charter schools under the
- 4 same pay schedule in the State. However, section 89-6, Hawaii
- 5 Revised Statutes, which designates various bargaining units,
- 6 does not explicitly include public charter school teachers and
- 7 other personnel, creating confusion about the extent to which
- 8 charter school teachers and personnel are included under the
- 9 State's collective bargaining laws. Accordingly, the purpose of
- 10 this Act is to clarify that teachers and other personnel of
- 11 state public charter schools under the same pay schedule are
- 12 part of collective bargaining unit (5) along with public school
- 13 teachers and other personnel employed under the same pay
- 14 schedule by the department of education.
- 15 SECTION 2. Section 89-6, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 16 amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows:

4	(1)	Nonsupervisory employees in blue collar positions;
5	(2)	Supervisory employees in blue collar positions;
6	(3)	Nonsupervisory employees in white collar positions;
7	(4)	Supervisory employees in white collar positions;
8	(5)	Teachers and other personnel of the department of
9		education and public charter schools under the same
10		pay schedule, including part-time employees working
11		less than twenty hours a week who are equal to one-
12		half of a full-time equivalent;
13	(6)	Educational officers and other personnel of the
14		department of education under the same pay schedule;
15	(7)	Faculty of the University of Hawaii and the community
16		college system;
17	(8)	Personnel of the University of Hawaii and the
18		community college system, other than faculty;
19	(9)	Registered professional nurses;
20	(10)	Institutional, health, and correctional workers;
21	(11)	Firefiahters

1	(12)	Police officers;
2	(13)	Professional and scientific employees, who cannot be
3		included in any of the other bargaining units;
4	(14)	State law enforcement officers; and
5	(15)	State and county ocean safety and water safety
6		officers."
7	SECT	ION 3. New statutory material is underscored.
8	SECT	ION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
