BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Chapter 396, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is

- 3 and to read as follows:
- 4 "§396- Occupational safety and health special fund;
- 5 establishment; purposes. (a) There is established within the
- 6 state treasury the occupational safety and health special fund,
- 7 to be administered by the department, into which shall be

- 9 (1) Fees collected pursuant to section 396-5.1;
- 10 (2) All civil penalties assessed pursuant to section
- 11 396-10; and
- 12 (3) Appropriations made by the legislature to the fund.
- 13 All interest earned or accrued on moneys deposited into the
- 14 occupational safety and health special fund shall become part of
- 15 the special fund.

1 Moneys in the occupational safety and health special 2 fund shall be expended by the department for the following 3 purposes: 4 (1) Personnel and operating expenses; and 5 Staff development and training fees and expenses. (2) 6 The unencumbered balance of the occupational safety (c) and health special fund exceeding \$ at the end of each 7 8 fiscal year shall be deposited into the general fund on or about 9 June 30 every year." 10 SECTION 2. Section 371-12.5, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 11 amended by amending its title and subsection (a) to read as 12 follows: 13 "[+] §371-12.5[+] Labor law enforcement special fund; 14 establishment; purposes. (a) There is established in the state 15 treasury the labor law enforcement special fund into which shall 16 be deposited: 17 (1)All penalties collected pursuant to section 388-9.7; 18 (2) All penalties collected pursuant to section 388-10; 19 [(3) All civil penalties assessed pursuant to section 20 396-10;
