A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO OCCUPATIONAL SAFETY AND HEALTH.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Chapter 396, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 2 amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated
- 3 and to read as follows:
- 4 "§396- Workforce safety and health special fund;
- 5 <u>establishment; purposes.</u> (a) There is established within the
- 6 state treasury the workforce safety and health special fund, to
- 7 be administered by the department, into which shall be
- 8 deposited:
- 9 (1) Fees collected pursuant to section 396-5.1;
- 10 (2) All civil penalties assessed pursuant to
- 11 section 396-10; and
- 12 (3) Appropriations made by the legislature to the fund.
- 13 All interest earned or accrued on moneys deposited into the
- 14 workforce safety and health special fund shall become part of
- 15 the special fund.
- 16 (b) Moneys in the workforce safety and health special fund
- 17 shall be expended by the department for the following purposes:



1 (1) Personnel and operating expenses; and 2 (2) Staff development and training fees and expenses. 3 (c) The unencumbered balance of the workforce safety and 4 health special fund exceeding \$ at the end of each 5 fiscal year shall be deposited into the general fund on or about June 30 of each year." 6 7 SECTION 2. Section 371-12.5, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is amended by amending its title and subsection (a) to read as 8 9 follows: 10 "[f]\$371-12.5[f] Labor law enforcement special fund; 11 establishment; purposes. (a) There is established in the state treasury the labor law enforcement special fund into which shall 12 13 be deposited: 14 All penalties collected pursuant to section 388-9.7; All penalties collected pursuant to section 388-10; 15 (2) 16 (3) All civil penalties assessed pursuant to section 17 396-10; 18 (4) [(3) Moneys appropriated by the legislature to the 19 fund; and $[\frac{(5)}{(5)}]$ (4) Any income and capital gains earned by the fund." 20

1 SECTION 3. Section 396-5.1, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 2 amended by amending subsection (b) to read as follows: 3 "(b) Fees received pursuant to subsection (a) shall be 4 deposited into the [general fund.] workforce safety and health special fund established pursuant to section 396- ." 5 SECTION 4. Section 396-10, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 6 7 amended by amending subsection (p) to read as follows: 8 "(p) All civil penalties collected pursuant to this 9 section shall be deposited into the [labor law enforcement] 10 workforce safety and health special fund established pursuant to 11 section 396- ." 12 SECTION 5. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed and stricken. New statutory material is underscored. 13

SECTION 6. This Act shall take effect on January 1, 2050.
