A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE DEPARTMENT OF HUMAN RESOURCES DEVELOPMENT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that the department of
- 2 human resources development is committed to providing the best
- 3 quality services to the State's employees and recruiting and
- 4 retaining the best and brightest personnel. The department's
- 5 employees are committed to making the State a desirable place to
- 6 work and support the fourteen thousand state employees
- 7 associated with the department.
- 8 The legislature further finds that state agencies are
- 9 currently facing staffing shortages and the average length of
- 10 time to hire a state employee can and should be reduced. The
- 11 legislature recognizes that technology-related infrastructure,
- 12 equipment, employees, and resources are key to helping the
- 13 department of human resources development address this staffing
- 14 shortage; however, the department of human resources development
- 15 lacks these technology-related resources. For example, eighty
- 16 per cent of the department's employees are using computers that
- 17 are more than ten years old. The legislature believes that

- 1 modernizing the computers and network infrastructure of the
- 2 department of human resources development will allow it to
- 3 provide faster responses, improve digital efficiencies, reduce
- 4 paper usage, and help the department better fulfill its mission.
- 5 Accordingly, the purpose of this Act is to appropriate
- 6 funds to enhance the department of human resources development's
- 7 technology resources so that it can better administer the state
- 8 human resources program, including human resources development
- 9 and training, and central human resources services such as
- 10 recruitment, examination, classification, pay administration,
- 11 and payment of any claims as required under chapter 386, Hawaii
- 12 Revised Statutes.
- SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
- 14 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so
- 15 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2023-2024 and
- 16 the same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal
- 17 year 2024-2025 for the enhancement of technology resources for
- 18 the department of human resources development and the
- 19 establishment of full-time equivalent (FTE) positions
- 20 in the department of human resources development.

- 1 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the department
- 2 of human resources development for the purposes of this Act.
- 3 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on June 30, 3000.
