## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO TELECOMMUNICATION.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that providing access for
- 2 residents to participate in the state legislative process is a
- 3 basic right of citizenship in the State and should continue to
- 4 be a priority. Providing equitable access to the legislative
- 5 process for nearly four hundred fifty thousand residents on
- 6 neighbor islands as well as those in rural Oahu is crucial to
- 7 improving the functionality of the legislative process. With
- 8 the rising costs of airfare, gas, and lodging, providing
- 9 designated locations or state offices on neighbor islands and in
- 10 rural Oahu where citizens can participate remotely in the
- 11 legislative process will help reduce the financial burden of
- 12 participation.
- 13 The purpose of this Act is to require the comptroller of
- 14 the department of accounting and general services to identify
- 15 certain state resources that can be utilized for
- 16 telecommunication access to increase neighbor island and rural
- 17 Oahu residents' participation in the state legislative process.

- 1 SECTION 2. (a) The comptroller of the department of
- 2 accounting and general services shall identify state office
- 3 buildings that are able to provide equitable telecommunication
- 4 access to allow residents of the counties of Hawaii, Kauai, and
- 5 Maui, and residents of rural areas in the city and county of
- 6 Honolulu, including residents with disabilities, to participate
- 7 remotely in legislative hearings.
- 8 (b) The comptroller shall submit a report of the findings
- 9 and recommendations, including any proposed legislation, to the
- 10 legislature no later than twenty days prior to the convening of
- 11 the regular session of 2024.
- 12 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on January 1, 2050.

## Report Title:

Department of Accounting and General Services; Comptroller; State Office Buildings; Telecommunications; Accessibility; Legislative Hearings; Report

## Description:

Requires the Comptroller to identify state office buildings that can provide equitable telecommunication access to allow certain residents, including residents with disabilities, to participate remotely in legislative hearings. Requires a report to the Legislature. Effective 1/1/2050. (SD1)

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
