A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO AIRLINES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that since January 2021,
- 2 only one passenger airline has provided service to the general
- public out of Molokai airport. While the airline has done their 3
- 4 best to accommodate the needs of passengers, including
- additional routes, flight times, and ordering larger planes, the 5
- cost of plane tickets remains a hinderance to many Molokai 6
- 7 residents who need to travel for essential reasons, including
- work, medical appointments, and family. A subsidy can help the 8
- 9 airlines offset the cost of passenger tickets while encouraging
- 10 other airlines to also provide service at Molokai airport.
- 11 The purpose of this Act is to require the department of
- 12 transportation to establish a one-year pilot program to provide
- 13 subsidies to airlines operating out of Molokai airport.
- 14 SECTION 2. (a) The department of transportation shall
- establish and implement a one-year airline subsidy pilot program 15
- at Molokai airport to assist airlines in offsetting the costs of 16
- **17** operation.



- 1 (b) The department of transportation shall submit a report
- 2 of its findings and recommendations regarding the airline
- 3 subsidy pilot program, including any proposed legislation, to
- 4 the legislature no later than twenty days prior to the convening
- 5 of the regular session of 2024.
- 6 SECTION 3. There is appropriated out of the general
- 7 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so
- 8 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2023-2024 and
- 9 the same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal
- 10 year 2024-2025 for the airline subsidy pilot program.
- 11 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the department
- 12 of transportation for the purposes of this Act.
- 13 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2050.
