RELATING TO MOTOR VEHICLE REGISTRATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Section 286-41, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is			
2	amended b	y ame	nding subsection (g) to read as follows:	
3	"(g)	The	provisions of this part requiring the	
4	registrat	ion o	f motor vehicles shall not apply to:	
5	(1)	Spec	ial mobile equipment;	
6	(2)	Impl	ements of husbandry temporarily drawn, moved, or	
7		othe	rwise propelled upon the public highways;	
8	(3)	Airc	raft servicing vehicles that are being used	
9		excl	usively on lands set aside to the department of	
10		tran	sportation for airport purposes; and	
11	(4)	Trac	tor trucks, flatbed trucks, forklifts, and top	
12		pick	s being used as marine terminal equipment	
13	,	temp	orarily moving in or between terminals at:	
14		(A)	Sand Island and along Sand Island Parkway and	
15			Sand Island Access Road;	
16		(B)	Kalanianaole Avenue between Kuhio Street and	
17			Kahanu Street, abutting Hilo Harbor;	

1	(C)	Kawaihae-Mahukona Road abutting Kawaihae Harbor;
2	(D)	East Kaahumanu Avenue between Hobron Avenue and
3		Kane Street, abutting Kahului Harbor; [and]
4	(E)	[Waipaa] <u>Waapa</u> Road abutting Nawiliwili
5		Harbor[-];
6	<u>(F)</u>	Nimitz Highway, from 8:30 a.m. to 3:00 p.m., and
7		from 6:30 p.m. to 5:30 a.m.;
8	(G)	Sand Island Access Road and Forrest Avenue,
9		including all roadways abutting pier accessways;
10		provided that vehicles abide by the speed limit
11		and keep up with the flow of traffic;
12	<u>(H)</u>	Auiki Street, abutting Kapalama Container
13		Terminal;
14	<u>(I)</u>	Malakole Street, abutting Barbers Point; and
15	(J)	Hanua Street, abutting Barbers Point; provided
16		that an escort vehicle is present."
17	SECTION 2	. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
18	and stricken.	New statutory material is underscored.
19	SECTION 3	. This Act shall take effect on June 30, 3000.

Motor Vehicle Registration; Flatbed Trucks; Exemption

Description:

Provides an exemption for flatbed trucks from registration renewals and initial registrations of motor carrier vehicles when used as marine terminal equipment temporarily moving in or between certain terminals. Adds new terminal locales, times, and roadways to be covered under the exemption. Effective 6/30/3000. (HD1)
