RELATING TO SOCIAL SERVICES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTI	ON 1. Section 346-53, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended by	amending subsection (c) to read as follows:
3	"(C)	The director, pursuant to chapter 91, shall determine
4	the rate o	of payment for domiciliary care, including care
5	provided i	n licensed developmental disabilities domiciliary
6	homes, com	munity care foster family homes, and certified adult
7	foster hom	nes, to be provided to recipients who are eligible for
8	federal su	applementary security income or public assistance, or
9	both. The	director shall provide for level of care payment as
10	follows:	
11	(1)	Beginning on [July 1, 2008,] October 1, 2024, for
12		adult residential care homes classified as facility
13		type I, licensed developmental disabilities
14		domiciliary homes as defined under section 321-15.9,
15		community care foster family homes as defined under
16		section 321-481, and certified adult foster homes as
17		defined under section 321-11.2, the state supplemental

1	payment, which includes the care rate and personal	
2	needs allowance, shall not exceed [\$651.90;] \$809; and	
3	(2) Beginning on [July 1, 2008,] <u>October 1, 2024,</u> for	
4	adult residential care homes classified as facility	
5	type II, the state supplemental payment, which	
6	includes the care rate and personal needs allowance,	
7	shall not exceed [\$759.90.] <u>\$917.</u>	
8	If the operator does not provide the quality of care	
9	consistent with the needs of the individual to the satisfaction	
10	of the department, the department may remove the recipient to	
11	another facility.	
12	The department shall handle abusive practices under this	
13	section in accordance with chapter 91.	
14	Nothing in this subsection shall allow the director to	
15	remove a recipient from an adult residential care home or other	
16	similar institution if the recipient does not desire to be	
17	removed and the operator is agreeable to the recipient	
18	remaining, except where the recipient requires a higher level of	
19	care than provided or where the recipient no longer requires any	
20	domiciliary care."

- 2 amended by amending subsection (c) to read as follows:
- 3 "(c) The State's supplemental payment for a needs
- 4 allowance under subsection (a) shall be increased by an amount
- 5 necessary to bring the allowance up to [\$50] \$75 per month. The
- 6 payment under this section shall be afforded to an individual
- 7 notwithstanding that the individual is incapacitated; provided
- 8 that the moneys may be spent on behalf of the client, with a
- 9 written accounting, by the operator of the residence or
- 10 facility."
- 11 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 12 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 13 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.

Description:

Amends the state supplemental payment ceiling for domiciliary care paid to recipients who are eligible for federal supplementary security income or public assistance, or both. Amends the monthly needs allowance for individuals residing in foster homes, care homes, domiciliary homes, and other long-term care facilities. (SD2)
