
SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE TO ESTABLISH A
SUSTAINABLE FOOD SYSTEMS WORKING GROUP TO DEVELOP AN
INTERAGENCY FOOD SYSTEMS PLAN.

1 WHEREAS, food security is a critical issue in the State;
2 and

3
4 WHEREAS, the State imports eight-five percent of its food,
5 making it vulnerable to natural and man-made disasters; and

6
7 WHEREAS, the State should be proactive in making its local
8 food production more resilient; and

9
10 WHEREAS, a sustainable food system is a food system in
11 which producers, retailers, community members, non-governmental
12 organizations, and government agencies partner to create a
13 vibrant and resilient local food economy that enhances and
14 sustains the environmental, economic, and social health of the
15 community; and

16
17 WHEREAS, the development of a sustainable food system for
18 the State would support "green" job creation, sustainable
19 economic development, land stewardship, and climate change
20 resiliency; and

21
22 WHEREAS, a coordinated food systems plan lead by key
23 stakeholders across the State is critical to develop a
24 sustainable and equitable food economy; now, therefore,

26 BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the Thirty-second
27 Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2024, the
28 House of Representatives concurring, that the Department of
29 Agriculture is requested to establish a Sustainable Food Systems
30 Working Group to develop an interagency food systems plan; and

1 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Chairperson of the Board of
2 Agriculture, or the Chairperson's designee and the Director of
3 Business, Economic Development, and Tourism, or the Director's
4 designee, are requested to serve as co-chairpersons of the
5 Sustainable Food Systems Working Group; and

7 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Sustainable Food Systems
8 Working Group include a member from the:

10 (1) Department of Health;

12 (2) Office of Hawaiian Affairs; and

14 (3) Office of Planning and Sustainable Development; and

16 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that one member of the House of
17 Representatives, to be selected by the Speaker of the House of
18 Representatives, and one member of the Senate, to be selected by
19 the President of the Senate, are requested to collaboratively
20 select and invite one representative with knowledge in each of
21 the following areas to serve as working group members:

38 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the interagency food systems
39 plan is requested to:

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36 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Sustainable Food Systems
37 Working Group is requested to submit the interagency food
38 systems plan and its recommendations for the implementation of
39 the plan, including any proposed legislation, to the Legislature
40 no later than twenty days prior to the convening of the Regular
41 Session of 2025; and

1 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Department of Agriculture
2 is requested to provide any necessary administrative support,
3 including support for the preparation of the interagency food
4 systems plan, to the Sustainable Food Systems Working Group; and
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6 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Sustainable Food Systems
7 Working Group is requested to be dissolved on June 30, 2025; and
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9 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this
10 Concurrent Resolution be transmitted to the Chairperson of the
11 Board of Agriculture; Director of Business, Economic
12 Development, and Tourism; Director of Health; Chief Executive
13 Officer of the Office of Hawaiian Affairs; and Director of the
14 Office of Planning and Sustainable Development.
