SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE AUDITOR TO CONDUCT AN AUDIT OF THE CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM, INCLUDING REPAIR AND MAINTENANCE, OF THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION.

WHEREAS, the Department of Education has two primary 1 responsibilities for the facilities of the State's public 2 repair and maintenance and capital improvement 3 schools: projects; and 4 5 WHEREAS, the condition of the State's school facilities 6 support the learning and development of Hawaii's keiki; and 7 8 WHEREAS, the myriad of needs for new buildings; repair and 9 maintenance of aging buildings; and upgrading and improving 10 safety, health, and technology infrastructure are the 11 responsibility of the Department of Education's Office of 12 Facilities and Operations; and 13 14 WHEREAS, effective and timely project execution is expected 15 by the schools but has been a challenge due to the length of 16 time from project appropriation to project completion; and 17 18 19 WHEREAS, the timely execution of projects requires appropriate collaboration between various stakeholders, 20 including government officials and agencies, school 21 administrators, facility managers and staff, consultants, and 22 contractors; and 23 24 WHEREAS, timely project execution is dependent on a number 25 of factors beyond the adequate scoping of projects and costs 26 27 such as the allotment release process; permitting approvals; and procurement, project management, and construction management; 28 29 and 30 WHEREAS, the Office of Facilities and Operations is 31 responsible for prioritizing projects based on need, managing 32

resources, and competing priorities and coordinating with school 1 administration to execute the projects expeditiously for the 2 3 State's public schools; now, therefore, 4 BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the Thirty-second 5 Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2024, the 6 House of Representatives concurring, that the Auditor is 7 requested to conduct an audit of the capital improvement 8 9 program, including repair and maintenance, of the Department of Education; and 10 11 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the audit is requested to 12 include but not be limited to the challenges faced by the 13 Department of Education in timely completion of projects, from 14 appropriation to allotment release; and project planning, 15 design, and construction completion; and 16 17 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Auditor is requested to 18 include an analysis of the adequacy of the Department of 19 20 Education's staffing capacity and other resources to address the volume of capital improvement and repair and maintenance 21 projects; and 22 23 24 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Auditor is requested to 25 consider the Department of Education's procedures in: 26 Assessment and planning, including prioritizing 27 (1) projects based on need and a comprehensive plan for 28 capital improvement projects; 29 30 Budgeting to fund identified priorities; and 31 (2) 32 (3) Implementation, including procurement of contractors 33 and materials; meeting with schools and consultants; 34 and overseeing and monitoring the project's progress 35 to completion; and 36 37 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the audit is requested to 38 39 include, based on a review of the aforementioned departmental procedures, an analysis comparing policies and procedures 40 against other state governmental agencies and county public 41

works functions to recommend best practices and efficiencies 1 that can be considered by the Department of Education; and 2 3 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Auditor is requested to 4 submit a report of its findings and recommendations for 5 improving the Department of Education's program for capital 6 improvement and repair and maintenance of the State's public 7 schools, to the Legislature no later than twenty days prior to 8 9 the convening of the Regular Session of 2025; and 10 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this 11 12 Concurrent Resolution be transmitted to the Auditor, Chairperson of the Board of Education, Superintendent of Education, and 13 Director of Budget and Finance. 14 15 16 17
