SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A STATEWIDE FIREFIGHTING AIRCRAFT PROGRAM.

1	WHEREAS, due to its geographical isolation, Hawaii faces
2	major barriers to effective wildfire response; and
3	
4	WHEREAS, while other states may request out-of-state
5	firefighting agencies under mutual aid agreements to assist in
6	coordinated firefighting efforts due to closer proximity and
7	connected land mass, Hawaii's geographical isolation and unique
8	topography make it increasingly difficult to request similar
9	assistance, only compounding the challenges that local
10	firefighters face in response to a wildfire; and
11	
12	WHEREAS, the threat of wildfires has increased in recent
13	decades due to climate change, adverse weather events, and drier
14	environmental conditions necessitating the State to adapt its
15	firefighting methodology; and
16	
17	WHEREAS, the adoption of a unified, state-driven approach
18	to firefighting would enhance fire safety throughout the State;
19	and
20	
21	WHEREAS, a statewide firefighting aircraft program is
22	imperative for the State to fortify resilience against wildfires
23	and enhance emergency management and response capabilities; and
24	
25	WHEREAS, the individual counties currently operate
26	firefighting helicopters, fixed wing aircraft, drones, and other
27	resources, that are difficult to deploy outside of a county
28	during times of mass emergencies; and
29	
30	WHEREAS, a helicopter's, fixed wing aircraft's, or drone's
31	ability to rapidly intervene in remote and inaccessible areas
32	dramatically increases firefighting capabilities, and if

equipped with state of the art technology can deliver targeted 1 water drops, fire retardant, and other fire suppression agents 2 with precision to maximize the efficiency of suppression 3 4 efforts; now, therefore, 5 6 BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the Thirty-second 7 Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2024, the House of Representatives concurring, that a statewide 8 firefighting aircraft program is requested to be established; 9 10 and 11 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Legislature is urged to 12 appropriate the necessary funds to create a dedicated statewide 13 firefighting aircraft program to fortify Hawaii's resilience 14 against wildfires, enhance emergency response capabilities, 15 protect the State's natural resources, and ensure the safety of 16 the State's residents and visitors; and 17 18 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the statewide firefighting 19 helicopter program is requested to retrofit, maintain, staff, 20 21 operate, and support firefighting helicopters, fixed wing aircraft, or drones or contract for the provision of these 22 services and enter into agreements with state and county fire 23 24 departments and emergency management agencies to establish 25 policies and procedures for the deployment of firefighting helicopters, fixed wing aircraft, or drones; and 26 27 28 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this 29 Concurrent Resolution be transmitted to the Governor, President of the Senate, Speaker of the House of Representatives, 30 Administrator of the Hawaii Emergency Management Agency, and 31 Chair of the State Fire Council. 32
