SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE AUDITOR TO CONDUCT A SOCIAL AND FINANCIAL ASSESSMENT ON MANDATING DENTAL AND VISION INSURANCE COVERAGE.

WHEREAS, over 223,000 Hawaii residents do not have dental 1 insurance coverage and the same number of residents, or more, 2 also do not have vision insurance coverage; and 3 4 WHEREAS, individuals without dental or vision insurance 5 coverage tend to not regularly visit a dentist or optometrist, 6 resulting in deteriorating dental or vision conditions that 7 could have been prevented if diagnosed early; and 8 9 10 WHEREAS, Senate Bill No. 2259, S.D. 2, Regular Session of 2024, requires insurance coverage for dental and vision 11 insurance coverage; and 12 13 WHEREAS, pursuant to section 23-51, Hawaii Revised 14 Statutes, before any legislative measure that mandates health 15 insurance coverage for specific health services, specific 16 17 diseases, or certain providers of health care services as part of individual or group health insurance policies, can be 18 considered, a concurrent resolution shall be passed requesting 19 the Auditor to prepare and submit to the Legislature a report 20 21 that assesses both the social and financial effects of the proposed mandated coverage under that legislative bill; now, 22 23 therefore, 24 25 BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the Thirty-second Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2024, the 26 27 House of Representatives concurring, that the Auditor is requested to conduct an impact assessment report, pursuant to 28 sections 23-51 and 23-52, Hawaii Revised Statutes, of mandating 29 dental and vision insurance coverage, as proposed in Senate Bill 30 No. 2259, S.D. 2, Regular Session of 2024; and 31



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2 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Auditor is requested to 3 submit a report of its findings and recommendations, including 4 any proposed legislation, to the Legislature no later than 5 twenty days prior to the convening of the Regular Session of 6 2025; and

9 Resolution be transmitted to the Auditor and Insurance
10 Commissioner.
