SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE BOARD OF EDUCATION TO RENAME JAMES CAMPBELL HIGH SCHOOL'S SOFTBALL FIELD AS THE LOKE HUDDY SOFTBALL FIELD.

1 WHEREAS, Aunty Loke Huddy has contributed significantly to
2 the betterment of the Ewa Beach community and the athletics
3 program of Campbell High School; and

5 WHEREAS, Aunty Loke's participation dates back to the late
6 1960s, when she began assisting her husband, Trask Huddy, in
7 coaching the track and field, volleyball, and junior varsity
8 girls basketball teams; and
9

10 WHEREAS, Aunty Loke was the first head coach of Campbell
11 High School's softball team, which was established in 1976, and
12 was the first female head coach at Campbell High School; and

14 WHEREAS, Aunty Loke served as head coach for Campbell High
15 School softball into the 1990s, and continued to assist Campbell
16 High School's athletics program in various capacities after
17 stepping down from that role; and

19 WHEREAS, in the early 2000s, Aunty Loke coached the running
20 back position for Campbell High School's football team; and

22 WHEREAS, as a testament to her skill and diverse coaching
23 talents, Aunty Loke helped Campbell High School's softball team
24 win three Oahu Interscholastic Association titles and four Oahu
25 Interscholastic Association West Division titles; and

27 WHEREAS, in honor of her thirty-plus years of service to
28 Campbell High School's athletics program, Aunty Loke was
29 recognized with two Coach of the Year awards, two Oahu
30 Interscholastic Association Outstanding Service awards, and a
31 Hawaii Interscholastic Athletic Directors Association award; and

1 WHEREAS, as a beloved community member, Aunty Loke was
 2 given the honor of being named Grand Marshall in an Ewa Beach
 3 Christmas Parade; and

 5 WHEREAS, Aunty Loke continues to enthusiastically support
 6 Campbell High School's athletics program as an avid attendee of
 7 games, helping to run the game clock, keep score, and officiate
 8 at games; and

 10 WHEREAS, in the broader community, Aunty Loke has
 11 volunteered with, coached, and officiated for community sports
 12 leagues such as Bobby Sox, Little League, and Pop Warner
 13 Football, and has also assisted the Kaimiloa Elementary School
 14 athletics program; and

 16 WHEREAS, beyond athletics, Aunty Loke has served in
 17 neighborhood watch programs, helped with community cleanup days,
 18 and demonstrated caring and compassion by providing nutritious
 19 meals to fellow community members during times of need; and

 21 WHEREAS, a person whose significant contributions have
 22 positively impacted the Ewa Beach community should be
 23 appropriately honored with a lasting reminder of her dedication;
 24 now, therefore,

 26 BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the Thirty-second
 27 Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2024, the
 28 House of Representatives concurring, that the Board of Education
 29 is requested to rename James Campbell High School's softball
 30 field as the Loke Huddy Softball Field, in recognition of Aunty
 31 Loke's accomplishments and contributions to James Campbell High
 32 School's athletics programs; and

 34 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this
 35 Concurrent Resolution be transmitted to the Chairperson of the
 36 Board of Education, Superintendent of Education, and Principal
 37 of James Campbell High School.
